## Types of Licenses

#### Each state is completely different

- Grow / cultivation
- 2. Extraction
- 3. Manufacturing
- 4. Distribution
- 5. Retail / Delivery

#### Very common for multiple royalty agreements on a license

- 1. You need to know who these agreements are with as they are on the license you are insuring
- 2. All activities tied to the license
  - Inventory
  - Liability
  - Reputation

#### BUSINESS INSURANCE.

## Seed to Shelf Tracking

- Allows for full transparency of cannabis throughout the supply chain (METRC and BioTrack)
- States with systems are more stable
  - Greater auditing capability
  - Increased financial transparency
  - Product recall
  - Shrinkage tracking
  - Tax liability

## Supply Chain Best Practices

- Written SOPs for the production of each SKU to ensure consistency and repeatability...potency of cannabis will fluctuate
- GMP certification of the production facility
- A Compliance Manager that reports outside of operations
- Consumer comment tracking
  - Pattern of defects
  - Adverse events

## Legal Review

- Legal review of new and revised packaging for state / federal compliance
- Marketing material review for claims
- Contracts and agreements

## **Testing**

- Ability to test product for potency in house (HPLC)
- Outside lab testing results vary greatly
- Incoming raw material testing (cannabis and non-cannabis)
  - Potency
  - Pesticides
  - Heavy metals
  - · Microbiological contaminants
  - Residual solvents
- 3<sup>rd</sup> party finished product testing
  - Potency
  - Contaminants
- Testing results should be kept for the shelf life of the product at a minimum
- Test results should be readily accessible for consumers and regulators
